Dutzendteich and Nazi Party Rally Grounds

Standing on the same ground where Nazis held their party rallies directly confronts students with difficult questions: How did these rallies convince so many people that their harmful ideology was worth following? Why would this monument be preserved? And what can we do today to prevent the atrocities the Nazi Regime committed from ever happening again?
